

Regular Meeting January 6, 2014 at Livingston City Hall at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Curtis Hayes called the meeting to order.

Bill Linder made the motion to accept the minutes as handed out. David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

David Langford made the motion to pass the 2nd Reading on Ordinance 2013-12-1 Rezoning Matthews, Twin Lakes Telephone property from R-2 to C-3. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Greg McDonald of the Downtown Revitalization Committee presented bills in the amount of \$46,708.93 to be paid out of Downtown Revitalization funds.

After discussion, Cindy Robbins made the motion to approve the bills to be paid out of Downtown Revitalization funds. Bill Winningham seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Johnny Halfacre, Airport Chairman, was present to discuss the FBO Contract. Eric Walker of Region Air currently has a 5 year contract with 5 year option to renew. Mr. Walker is asking to be released from the contract. Chairman Halfacre stated that James Sells of Vertical Flight LLC was interested in being the FBO. This contract would be for 1 year with 1 year option. Chairman Halfacre stated that he thinks a lot has been accomplished at the airport in the last 4 years.

Mayor Hayes thanked Eric Walker for the time and effort in helping the city at the airport.

David Langford made the motion to release Eric Walker from the FBO contract. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

David Langford made the motion to enter into a 1 year contract with 1 year option with Vertical Flight LLC. Bill Winningham seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Mayor Hayes reported that the city needs to adopt the 2012 International Codes. There will be a work session to discuss the codes on Monday, February 3, 2014 at 5:15 p.m.

Police Chief Greg Etheredge reported that they were going to decommission a 2002 and 2003 police car. They are also going to sell some equipment that is no longer needed. These items will be put on Gov.Deals. The items will have a reserve.

Cindy Robbins made the motion to approve the sale of these items. David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

David Langford made the motion that anyone considered for employment has to live in Overton County. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Cindy Robbins made the motion to adjourn. David Langford seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.
