

Regular Meeting of the Livingston Mayor and Board of Alderman on April 7, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. at Livingston City Hall.

Mayor Curtis Hayes called the meeting to order.

Bill Linder made the motion to accept the minutes as handed out. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

The Board discussed the 2012 International Codes.

Bill Linder made the motion to adopt the first reading on Ordinances adopting the 2012 International codes. David Langford seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Greg McDonald representing the Downtown Revitalization Committee presented the following bills in the amount of \$69,278.59 to be paid for out of Downtown Revitalization Funds:

1. Better Lawns (Trim/Clean-up Square)	60.00

6. Merchant's Assoc. (Lighted Snowflakes)	10,279.00

He also reported on several projects that had been done and projects that are being worked on. Mr. McDonald addressed the Board concerning Hargis Upholstery's question as to why their project was not funded. He stated that approximately \$4000.00 had been spent on the sidewalk that adjoins their building. He stated that the committee had asked them to submit 3 years of sales tax information which they did not do.

Alderman Sadler stated that she had recently brought him the sales tax information.

The Board discussed the Live in Livingston events. Alderman Sadler stated that he thought that the Board was going to have a work session on this before any more events were approved.

Mayor Hayes stated that they could have a called meeting tomorrow night at 5:00 p.m.

David Sadler made the motion to approve \$18,778.59 (#1, 2, 3, 5 & 6) be paid out of Downtown Revitalization Funds (#4 was not approved). David Langford seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

David Sadler made the motion to pass 1st Reading on Ordinance 2014-4-1 (Amend Zoning Ordinance by adopting minimum standards for all above ground fuel storage tanks. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Cindy Robbins made the motion to approve the following to work at the City Park and Pool:

David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Mayor Hayes presented the Personnel Policy Update as recommended by MTAS

Lynn King made the motion to approve the Personnel Policy. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

David Langford made the motion to approve the hiring of Nathaniel Strong from part-time to full time in the Street Department as recommended by Street Supt. Wayne Peek. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Mayor Hayes read Tommy Johnson's letter of resignation. Police Chief Greg Etheredge recommended that Sam Carpenter be hired to replace Tommy Johnson. Sam Carpenter has been working part-time.

David Langford made the motion for Sam Carpenter to be hired full time as police officer. Lynn King seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Mayor Hayes reported that Clean Up Week is April 7th thru April 11th.

Mayor Hayes stated that AAU of TN (Lee Crowder) had asked permission to use the City Lake for 2.0 Wakeboard. This would be at no expense to the city. Also, the city's insurance carrier would have to approve this use.

After discussion, Mayor Hayes stated that this will be put on the May agenda and he will have Lee Crowder present to answer any questions.

Alderman Sadler ask about the use of E-Cigarettes at the City Park.

Mayor Hayes stated that this will be put on the May agenda so that the this matter can be researched.

Bill Linder made the motion to adjourn. Bill Winningham seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.
