

Regular Meeting of the Livingston Mayor and Board of Alderman on May 5, 2014 at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Curtis Hayes called the meeting to order.

Cindy Robbins made the motion to accept the minutes as handed out. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Bill Linder made the motion to accept the 2nd Reading on Ordinance 2014-4-1 (Above Ground Fuel Storage Tanks). Bill Winningham seconded the motion. (It was stated that existing tanks are grandfathered in). The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Greg McDonald representing the Downtown Revitalization Committee presented bills in the amount of \$15,954.52 to be paid out of Downtown Revitalization Funds.

Lynn King made the motion to approve the bills being paid out of Downtown Revitalization Funds. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Greg McDonald stated that Sierra Hull would be performing at one of the Live in Livingston events.

Bill Winningham made the motion to award the Tank Painting Contract (under ARC grant) to Huffman Tank. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Bill Winningham made the motion to approve CT-0253 on Livingston DWF 14-144. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Bill Linder made the motion to approve CT-0253 on Livingston DWF 14-146. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Mayor Hayes stated that in the new Personnel Policy current employees working 25 years or more receives 4 weeks vacation and new hires after April 1, 2014 would have to work 30 years before receiving 4 weeks vacation.

Chief Etheredge reported his findings on E-Cigarettes. It is his recommendation that e-cigarette smokers abide by the same policy as other smokers. They will have to go to the parking lot.

David Sadler made the motion that E-Cigarette smokers have to go to the parking lot to smoke. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Lee Crowder of AAU-TN was present to ask permission to use City Lake for ski cable system. There will be no motor boats; the floating dock would be portable. He stated that they would carry their own insurance and would release the city from any liability. He stated that the nearest ski-cable system was 4 hours away and he thought Livingston would be a good location for one.

After discussion, Lynn King made the motion to approve a 1 year lease with AAU-TN for \$1.00 provided the city's insurance carrier approves. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Mayor Hayes reported that the Overton County Grounds Committee has given permission for the city to maintain the courthouse grounds (mow grass, plant trees, etc.) Any cost would be paid for out of Downtown Revitalization funds.

Cindy Robbins made the motion to approve the city maintaining the courthouse grounds. David Langford seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

David Langford made the motion to approve the hiring of Ted Gunnels as meter reader in the Water Department. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Police Chief Etheredge recommended that Donnie Andrews be hired as dispatcher. Chief Etheredge stated that Keith Smith would be moved to patrol.

Lynn King made the motion to hire Donnie Andrews as dispatcher. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Bill Linder made the motion to adjourn. David Langford seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.
