

Regular Meeting February 2, 2015 at Livingston City Hall at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Curtis Hayes called the meeting to order.

Bill Linder made the motion to accept the minutes as handed out. David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Greg McDonald representing the Downtown Revitalization Committee presented bills to be paid out of Downtown Revitalization funds. Mr. McDonald stated that he was not presenting the BWS& C bills to be paid until he could get a more in depth explanation on what these bills were for.

After discussion, Cindy Robbins made the motion to approve the bills in the amount of \$5,627.63 to be paid for out of downtown revitalization funds. David Langford seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Alderman Langford stated that he would like to know exactly how much BWS&C has been paid.

Alderman Linder ask when will the sidewalks on S. Church Street be built. Street Supt. Wayne Peek stated that it would probably be April before concrete could be poured for the sidewalks.

David Langford made the motion to approve the purchase of boots for employees. The city will pay up to \$75.00 and the employees can purchase the boots in Livingston or anywhere else. They will need to bring their receipt in so that that they can be reimbursed up to \$75.00. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Airport Chairman Johnny Halfacre reported that the beacon light was not working. He stated that he would like to apply for \$20,000.00 grant. This grant is a 5% grant. He stated that the county has agreed to pay for \$500.00 provided the city pays \$500.00.

Cindy Robbins made the motion to apply for the grant and for the city to pay \$500.00 of the 5% match. Bill Winningham seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Chief Etheredge recommended that Dakota Hunter be hired as dispatcher to replace Justin Bowman.

David Langford made the motion to approve the hiring of Dakota Hunter as dispatcher. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Bill Linder made the motion to adjourn. Bill Winningham seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.
