Mayor Curtis Hayes called the meeting to order.

The Board discussed the proposal from Tri-Star Energy on Public Awareness and if the city could afford the extra expense. The proposal is for a 3 year contract at \$1,000.00 per month.

CMFO Joel Parks stated that the gas fund is strong enough to cover this expense.

Bob Parks of Tri-Star Energy addressed the Board on what they are getting for their money. One of the things is additional training 4 times a year.

The Board ask what the city had done in the past and what would it take to bring the gas supervisor up to speed where the gas department could do the work themselves.

It was stated that the Gas Supervisor would have to attend school and there would be lots of paperwork.

Alderman Langford ask if Tri Star would be willing to help the city at a later date if they were called. They responded that they would come if they were called.

Alderman Linder stated that he thought the city needs to stand on its own two feet.

Mayor Hayes stated that he can call Tennessee Regulatory Authority to see what schools are available.

The Board discussed just approving the proposal for 1 year.

David Sadler made the motion to approve the proposal for 1 year. Motion failed due to lack of second.

Bill Linder made the motion to adjourn. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 4 yes and 0 no.

The Board then had a work session on pay scale and ball park.
