

Regular meeting of the Livingston Mayor and Board of Alderman on March 7, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at Livingston City Hall.

Mayor Curtis Hayes called the meeting to order.

Bill Linder made the motion to accept the minutes as handed out. David Langford seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Cindy Robbins made the motion to pass the 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading on the Storm Water Management Ordinance. David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Greg McDonald, representing the Downtown Revitalization Committee presented the following invoices in the amount of \$635.00 to be paid out of downtown revitalization funds.

National Main Street Center (dues)	\$350.00
Better Lawns (change banners and maintenance of square)	285.00

David Sadler made the motion to approve these invoices being paid out of downtown revitalization funds. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Greg McDonald also gave an update on the Central Park project. He received this report from Darius Sims this afternoon.

Tommy Lee of UCDD presented a Resolution to Apply to the Tennessee Department of Health Project Diabetes program. This grant is for 450,000.00 which would be over a 3 year period. There is no local match required. This project is to encourage health and fitness of the citizens.

Bill Linder made the motion to approve Resolution 2016-3-1 (Diabetes Program). Bill Winningham seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

City Attorney John Meadows presented Resolution 2016-3-2 (A resolution to pursue legal action to recover for damages to city property).

Alderman Langford stated that there was no guarantee that we will get our money. He thinks that we should turn it over to our insurance. Mayor Hayes stated that the city's deductible is \$1,000.00. City Attorney John Meadows stated that the cost for filing the civil suit would be \$130.00.

After discussion, Bill Winningham made the motion to adopt the Resolution and that we have the fence fixed in the morning. David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

David Sadler made the motion to hire Rusty Withrow and Tracy McDonald II as meter readers. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

David Langford made the motion to hire Tyler Copeland in the Sanitation Department. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Alderman Langford stated that he had been contacted about the alley behind the Picker's Palace where some people are parking needing rock.

Mayor Hayes stated that he would check to see if this is a city owned alley.

Bill Linder made the motion to adjourn. Bill Winningham seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.
