

Regular Meeting May 2, 2016 at Livingston City Hall at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Curtis Hayes called the meeting to order.

Bill Linder made the motion to accept the minutes as handed out. David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no

Greg McDonald representing the Downtown Revitalization Committee presented the following bills in the amount of \$789.00 to be paid out of Downtown Revitalization funds:

David Sadler made the motion to pay these invoices out of Downtown Revitalization funds. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Mr. McDonald gave an update of the progress of the stage and drainage project at Central Park.

Tommy Lee, Director of Economic and Community Development at UCDD announced that the Town of Livingston had received a \$450,000.00 Diabetes Grant. This grant is a zero match grant. Mr. Lee stated that this was a very competitive grant. He stated that this would be a 3 year grant with \$150,000.00 each year. The first year will be for playground equipment at Central Park and the remaining 2 years will be for playground equipment at the Livingston Housing Authority and more equipment at Central Park. He stated that the money has to stay within the scope of the grant.

Water Supt. Tim Coffee stated that they were in need of an inspection camera. The low bid was \$10,500.00.

David Sadler made the motion to buy the inspection camera for \$10,500.00 David Langford seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

The alderman vacancy was discussed. Mayor Hayes stated that he understood that it was the consensus of the Board that after the election on June 1st that they would interview the 3 candidates that were not elected and select one to fill the vacant position.

Cindy Robbins made the motion for the Board of Alderman to interview the 3 candidates that were not elected as Alderman and to select one of them to fill the vacant alderman position. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Water Supt. Tim Coffee presented a proposal for a GPS System. He stated that this would show exactly where the water meters were located. We have been fortunate that we had meter readers that had worked for years and knew where the meters were but these meter readers have retired or would be retiring in the near future. He stated that anyone would be able to take the laptop and be able to locate the meters.

The bids for this system are as follow:

Magnolia River	\$26,000.00
Overton Co. E911	10,000.00

Mayor Hayes stated that they would also need to purchase 4 laptops which would cost approximately \$400.00 each.

David Sadler made the motion to approve the GPS system at \$10,000.00 and to purchase 4 laptops at \$400.00 each. This purchase is to be paid out of the Water Fund and Gas Fund. Bill Winningham seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Cindy Robbins made the motion to adjourn. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.
