

Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Board of Alderman on August 1, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at Livingston City Hall.

Mayor Curtis Hayes called the meeting to order.

Cindy Robbins made the motion to accept the minutes as handed out. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

David Langford made the motion to pass the 2nd Reading on Ordinance 2016-7-1 (An Ordinance amending the Zoning Ordinance by allowing second story and above single family residential as a permitted use in the C-2 (Central Business) Zoning District. David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Bill Linder made the motion to pass the 2nd Reading on Ordinance 2016-7-2 (Ordinance changing the Hunter property at 820 Oak Street from R-1 to C-1). David Langford seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

The Board discussed the alderman vacancy.

After discussion, Bill Linder made the motion to appoint David Sadler to fill the unexpired term of Lynn King. David Langford seconded the motion. The vote was 4 yes with Cindy Robbins voting no.

Greg McDonald, representing the Downtown Revitalization Committee, presented the following bills in the amount of \$535.00 to be paid out of downtown revitalization funds:

Better Lawns	\$349.00
Better Lawns	186.00

Cindy Robbins made the motion to approve these bills being paid out of downtown revitalization funds. David Langford seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Greg McDonald also gave an update on the Central Park project. Alderman Langford ask if the project was on budget. Mr. McDonald replied that it was.

Virginia Solimine of UCDD presented Resolution 2016-8-1 (Authorizing participation in National Cooperative purchasing alliance and execution of cooperative purchasing agreements). She stated that items could be purchased without bids from companies that were in the alliance. There is no membership to join.

Bill Winningham made the motion to adopt Resolution 2016-8-1. David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

The Board of Alderman reviewed the electrical bid for Central Park. Robbins and Garrett was the only bidder and their bid was \$140,920.00 (light fixtures \$128,420.20 and equipment \$12,500.00).

Bill Linder made the motion to accept the bid from Robbins and Garrett in the amount of \$140,920.00. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Zac Littrell of Atmos Energy gave an update on the natural gas market. He stated that the city should be okay on storage this winter. If we have a brutal winter this year, there might be a problem with storage next summer and winter. The city has a hedge on the price until March 2017.

Police Chief Etheredge reported that National Night Out is tomorrow night at the Livingston City Park.

Alderman Robbins stated that she wanted to thank the voters for allowing her to serve as Alderman and that she wished the new Alderman good luck.

David Sadler made the motion to adjourn. Cindy Robbins seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.
