

Called Meeting of the Livingston Mayor and Board of Alderman on January 26, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. at Livingston City Hall.

Mayor Curtis Hayes called the meeting to order.

Mayor Hayes stated that this meeting was to discuss the water supervisor position.

Mayor Hayes informed the Board that after talking with Jerry Kennedy and B. J. Norrod that B. J. is a little nervous about some of the responsibilities of being the supervisor. He is willing to be second in command for a little more money. Jerry Kennedy is still interested in being the supervisor. Eric Ramsey did not receive his certification.

Mayor Hayes stated that the pay rate for the supervisor would be \$19.00.

Alderman Linder stated that he thought \$19.00 was a fair price. At first he didn't think so but after doing some research he decided it was.

After discussion, Bill Linder made the motion to give the following raises:

Asst. Supervisor B. J. Norrod: \$16.55 to \$17.30
Backhoe Operator Eric Ramsey: \$12.00 to \$12.50

David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

The Board also discussed how on call was handled. Mayor Hayes stated that whoever was on call received \$30.00 per day.

Mayor Hayes stated that there would not be a work session on pay scale tonight because he doesn't have the numbers ready. He stated that this information will be ready by the time we start working on the budget.

Ronald Dishman made the motion to adjourn. David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.
