

Regular meeting August 7, 2017 at Livingston City Hall at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Curtis Hayes called the meeting to order.

David Sadler made the motion to approve the minutes as handed out. Ronald Dishman seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

David Langford made the motion to approve the following items being added to the agenda

Ronald Dishman seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

David Sadler made the motion to approve these items being paid out of downtown revitalization funds. Bill Winningham seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

David Langford made the motion to appoint Barbie Roberts to the Board of Zoning Appeals to replace Jane Ann Officer who resigned. Bill Winningham seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

David Langford made the motion to approve the hiring of Jordan Danner as certified police officer as recommended by Chief Etheredge. Ronald Dishman seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Police Chief Etheredge recommended that the 2012 Gray Charger be placed on GOV.DEALS to be sold. It has had some electronic problems.

Bill Linder made the motion to sell the 2012 Gray Charger on GOV.DEALS. David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Alderman Langford stated that he had received some complaints from the residents of W. Seventh Street concerning big trucks parking on the Burger King lot. He said that they were upset about the noise, dust, etc. He stated that the trucks needed a place for them to park and wondered if we could offer them an option to park elsewhere. He suggested that they could use the City Industrial Park. He stated that the city has the manpower and equipment to fix them a place to park. They would have to have some rock.

It was stated that we couldn't stop them from parking.

Mayor Hayes stated that he had talked with Joe Wilmouth who owns the lot that they are parking on and Mr. Wilmouth had suggested a 2 hour parking.

After discussion, the Board took no action on this matter.

David Langford made the motion to hire Dustin Collins to work in the Sanitation Dept. to replace Wyatt Farago who had resigned. Ronald Dishman seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Alderman Dishman stated that he thought that thumb print time cards were needed. He stated that the cost of thumb print time machine that he had seen ranged from \$239.00 to 459.00 per unit.

Some of the alderman questioned why this was needed. What is the problem and if there is a problem we need to address it.

Alderman Dishman also stated that he would like to see GPS on city vehicles and that gas logs needs to be kept.

It was stated that when employees get gasoline, someone at the police department records the gallons and the vehicle it went it.

Again it was stated that if there is a problem, we need to find out who or what it is.

Bill Winningham made the motion to adjourn. David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.
