

Regular meeting of the Livingston Mayor and Board of Alderman on January 2, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at Livingston City Hall.

Mayor Curtis Hayes called the meeting to order.

Ronald Dishman made the motion to accept the minutes as handed out. Bill Linder seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Mayor Hayes ask if there were any additions or deletions to the agenda.

Ken Dodson made the motion to approve the invoices in the amount of \$166,122.40 being paid out of downtown revitalization funds. David Sadler seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.

Some alderman proposed dropping the truck that would be used as a welder truck. It was also ask if the welder could be hauled on a trailer instead.

Street Supt. Wayne Peek stated that no department had a truck that could haul the welding equipment at this time.

Mayor Hayes suggested dropping the four-door ½ Ton. The total bid from Humboldt CDJR would be \$140,288.00 which would not be over the budgeted amount for vehicles.

After discussion, Ken Dodson made the motion to approve the bid from Humboldt CDJR for 3 (2 door ½ ton) trucks, 1 (4 door ¾ ton) truck and 1(2 door 1 ton with 8 ft. bed) truck for a total of \$140,288.00. Ronald Dishman seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes with David Langford voting no.

Mayor Hayes presented Ordinance 2017-12-1 (Rezoning property at 820 Oak Street from C-1 to R-1 Billy McClerran property).

David Sadler made the motion to pass the 2nd Reading on Ordinance 2017-12-1. Ken Dodson seconded the motion. The vote was 6 yes and 0 no.
