Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order.

Jimmy Gregory, UCEMC General Manager and Ben Wunningham, UCEMC District Office Manager was present to discuss the possibility of changing the street lights to LED. Mr. Gregory stated that there is a possibility that the city could save \$3,000 to 5,000 per month based on the current amount of street lights the city currently has.

They stated that they are willing to do a pilot program of about 30 street lights so that the city could see what they would look like. Some of the LED's will be R2 and some will be R3. They would probably put some up on the Cookeville Hwy. as you come into town. They also will put some up in a residential neighborhood.

After discussion, Ken Dodson made the motion to approve the LED Pilot Program of up to 30 street lights which will be at no additional cost to the city. Kelly Coleman seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.
