

Regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Alderman on June 3, 2019 at Livingston City Hall at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Curtis Hayes called the meeting to order.

Ken Dodson made the motion to accept the minutes as handed out. Ronald Dishman seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Ken Dodson made the motion to pass the 2nd Reading on Ordinance 2019-5-1 (Junkyards). Chris Speck seconded the motion. The vote was 3 yes with Ronald Dishman and David Langford voting no.

Ray Evans gave an update on some grants. He stated that the Façade grant would be available in August. He said that he hasn't heard from the Tourism Grant. There is a meeting this week with the State on the Multi-Modal Grant.

David Langford made the motion to approve the purchase of a 2016 Dodge Charger from the Missouri State Highway Patrol for \$16,950.00. This will be paid for out of drug fund. Ronald Dishman seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

The Board reviewed the proposed T-Hangar Lease agreement with Johnny Coleman.

After discussion, Chris Speck made the motion to approve the T-Hangar lease agreement. David Langford seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Mayor Hayes presented a letter from U C E M C on the progress of converting street lights to LED. The letter stated that Phase 1 work order is nearly complete and Phase 2 work order is in progress.

Bridget Bennett reported that the Farmers Market Committee had recommended a rule change to the Farmer's Market Rules and Regulations. The recommended change is that the vendor fees will be paid to City Hall instead of someone collecting them at the Farmer's Market.

Ronald Dishman made the motion to approve the rule change. Chris Speck seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Mayor Hayes stated that interviews had been held for the Building Inspector position and that he was recommending that Kristian Mansell be hired as building inspector. His starting salary would be \$40,000.00 per year.

David Langford made the motion to hire Kristian Mansell as Building Inspector. Ronald Dishman seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.

Mayor Hayes reported that there would be a called meeting on the budget on June 6th at 5:00 p.m.

Ronald Dishman made the motion to adjourn. Ken Dodson seconded the motion. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no.
